# Teacher Housing / Fortbay

Tuesday Fortbay's project goes in front of city council. I plan on making a general favorable comment to council about approving the project.

#### Construction

Due to the rain, both the district office and Vargas elementary are likely to experience a slight delay. This will not impact the final move or our opening but it will slow some of the outside construction work down.

Construction on both play structures, Stevenson and Mistral, is underway. Expected completion is this summer.

To capitalize on space and maximize building usage we are going to move nurses and district storage to the current location of the district office. We will also dedicate one portable for Stevenson to accommodate for the lack of storage that exists at the site.

Due to enrollment concerns we are going to move the moderate / severe special day class (SDC) from Huff to Monta Loma. Even after exempted 5<sup>th</sup> graders leave Huff, we will need every classroom on campus to meet the neighborhood enrollment demands.

From the Chief Academic Officer

This week a draft of the Local Control Accountability Plan was posted to the District website with a form for stakeholder input. Additionally, the draft was shared at the District English Learner Advisory Meeting. An overview of the LCAP, survey data, changes, budget and Federal Addendum was presented to the Board of Trustees on May 16. Cathy Baur and Tara Vikjord met with the middle school math team to discuss the first year of revised pathways and discuss areas for improvement. Cathy also met with the Assistant Superintendents of Los Altos Elementary and Mountain View-Los Altos Union High School District to discuss various topics including their plan to align science expectations for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders by the 2020-21 school year.

## Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment

This week in the Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Department, the team has been working to support make up tests, completion, and entering appropriate information into the testing system before the end of state testing. It has been a smooth CAASPP testing season that will be ending on May 24.

Benchmark assessments are still underway with students finishing their reading and writing assessments. The new math placement tests are set to begin next week. We are looking forward to seeing all of the results.

Tara Vikjord has been working with elementary sites to refine their RTI plans for the upcoming year. She also has been working with members of the County Office of Education to develop and plan for professional development in the fall. Tara and Cathy Baur met with the middle school math department and administrators to discuss math courses in 2019-20. She has also been working with the technology department to make sure all classes that will be included in the middle school master schedule are in alignment with the new state guidelines.

Tara facilitated the RTI meeting this week, focusing on best practices that will be carried through to the program next year and the coaches meeting, focusing on effective coaching practices in and for the District.
